#### Guidelines

## Guidelines

Habitat for Humanity of Mason County is a Faith-Based housing ministry financed through private donations, grant funding and support from our retail stores. We build homes with, and sell to, families who could not otherwise afford a home. Homeowners must be able and willing to pay an affordable mortgage. Mortgage payments are cycled back into the community to help build additional Habitat Homes.

- 1. <u>To qualify, you must have a housing need.</u> For example, inadequate plumbing and/or heating, leaky roof, overcrowding (3 or more to a bedroom), unsafe or unsanitary conditions.
- 2. <u>MUST be a current resident of Mason County for at least one year.</u>
- 3. <u>Have a steady gross income of 30-65% of the current median income for Mason County</u> based on the income grid generated by the HUD (United States Department of Housing and Urban Development). Verification of income, personal and credit references will be completed by a lender through Homesight or USDA (United Sates Department of Agriculture) for a 502 direct loan.
- 4. <u>After approval by the Family Selection Committee</u>, you must work with Homesight to receive a mortgage preapproval letter or a 502 USDA direct loan that you will submit to our office. Please notify Homesight that you are working with Habitat for Humanity of Mason County.
- 5. <u>Be willing to partner with Habitat for Humanity</u> in building your home, be a good steward of your home, and continue to work with Habitat for Humanity of Mason County in helping others become homeowners.
- 6. **If approved by the Family Selection Committee and Board of Directors for a Habitat for Humanity of Mason County home**, you must be willing to participate in programs to learn budgeting, home maintenance and other related topics.
- 7. **If approved by the Family Selection Committee and Board of Directors for a Habitat for Humanity of Mason County home**, you must work 250 – 350 hours of sweat equity. Fifty (50) hours must be performed before construction of your home begins. At least 100-200 hours must be performed by the Homeowners. The remaining hours may be done by friends, other family members and volunteers. You will need to contribute \$2,500 to closing cost.
- 8. If you meet all of the requirements and are approved by the Family Selection Committee and Board of Directors, we will sell you a home at fair market value. Mortgage payments are matched to your income and include insurance and property taxes. Property tax and insurance increases will increase monthly payments in future years.
- 9. <u>Applicants must not have any real estate ownership and bankruptcies must have been discharged for at least four</u> (4) years.
